Families of BMCS,

As we continue to monitor the guidelines and changes faced with Covid 19 we pray that the following Health and Safety information will be helpful. These plans are subject to change. We plan on opening with in-classroom instruction on Monday August 31.

1. Parents, please screen your child(ren) before they leave for school each morning. No student should be sent to school with a fever or any other symptoms. No touch thermometers will be used to check students when there is a concern. Parents will be called immediately to come and pick their child up if we have concerns.
2. Students must provide a note from a doctor for any length of time that they are off school.
3. All faculty and staff will follow the same guidelines as students.
4. Proper hand washing, coughing, and sneezing procedures will be gone over so that proper etiquette is emphasized.
5. Face masks will not be required unless a parent wants their child to wear one. Masks will be voluntary for students, faculty and staff. We will continue to monitor Government guidelines regarding this policy.
6. No touch hand sanitizers will be placed through out the school and each classroom will be provided with the regular pump hand sanitizer.
7. All rooms will be disinfected each day after school. During the day high touched areas will be wiped down.
8. Signs will be posted through out the school as a reminder to wash hands and maintain social distancing when possible.
9. We will do our best to make sure desks are placed at a proper distance and facing the same direction.
10. We will still have Hot Lunch and Pizza lunch. We will make sure the lunches will be served safely. There will be no sharing of food or drinks.

11. At lunch, there will be proper spacing between each student, while still allowing them to have social interaction.
12. Students may bring in their own water bottle to be used through out the day. When necessary students may refill at the no touch water fountain. Water bottles should be taken home nightly to be washed.
13. The gym equipment and playground equipment will be cleaned after gym classes and recess on a regular basis.
14. Parents and volunteers will be allowed on a limited basis. We are trying to maintain a healthy environment. Please be understanding during this time.
15. Classes and common areas will be ventilated with outdoor air when possible.
16. Teachers will at times have class outdoors when weather permits.
17. School assemblies and programs will be reviewed on a regular basis.
18. Our athletic teams will follow these guidelines and the ones put forth by PCAC.
19. Administrator Greg Firestone and Secretary Norma Young will be the ones to communicate information to the school families in case anyone tests positive for Covid-19. Communication will be by e-mail and text message.
